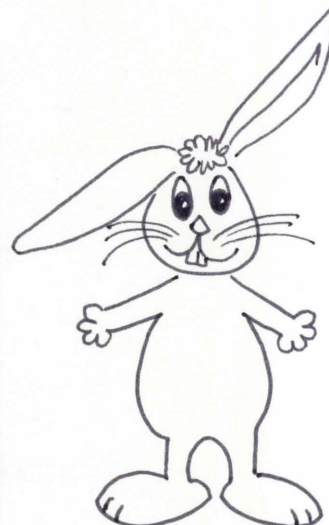

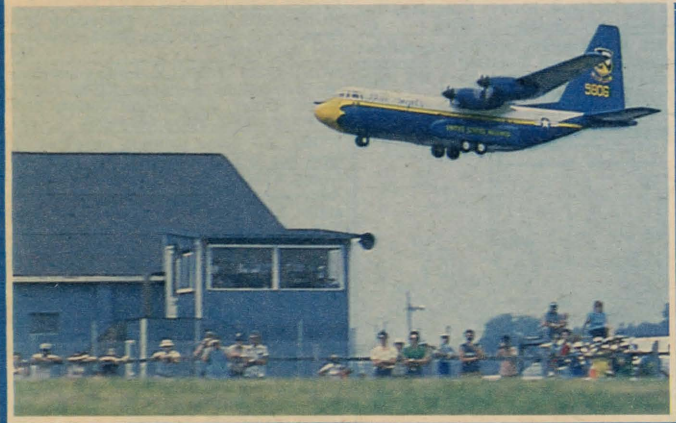

World's Biggest Model Airplane

The world's biggest model airplane stands next to the huge C-130 transport that inspired it (right). The incredible model is a one-fourth scale replica of the C-130 that was used by the U.S. Navy's famed Blue Angels aerobatic team to haul supplies to their performances — and four of the Angels posed next to it with builder Bob Campbell, second from left, of North Canton, Ohio. Below, the model takes off by radio remote control. It has a 20-foot wingspan, weighs 205 pounds and is powered by four chain saw engines. One of Campbell's realistic plane models, a B-29 bomber, was used as a filming prop in the movie "The Right Stuff."

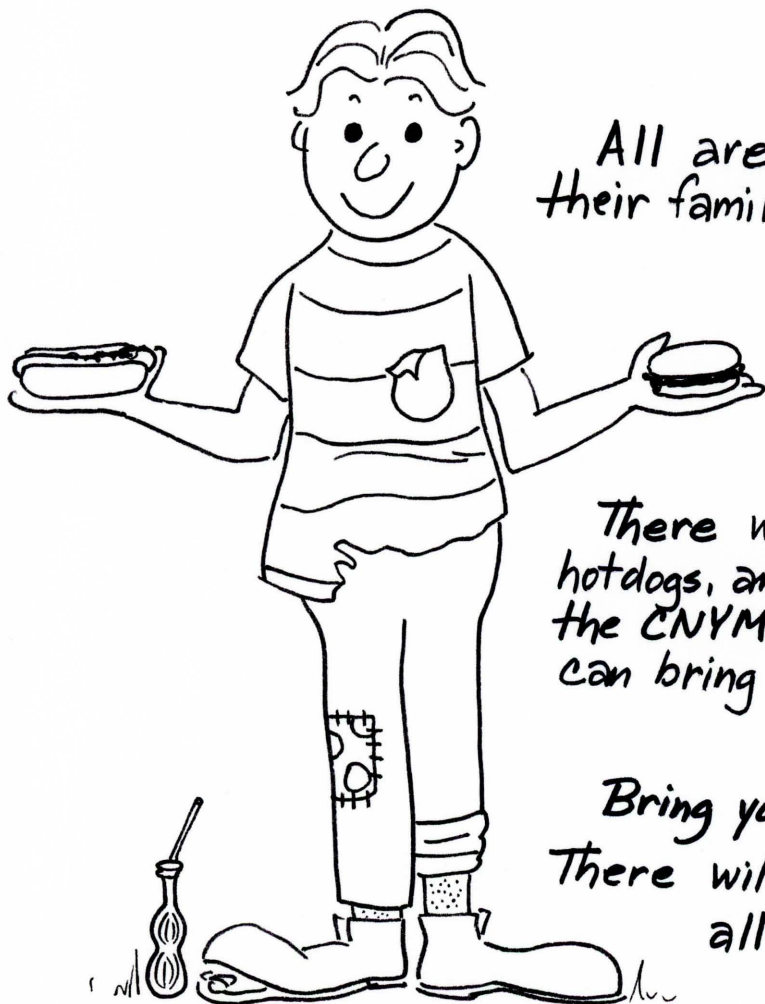

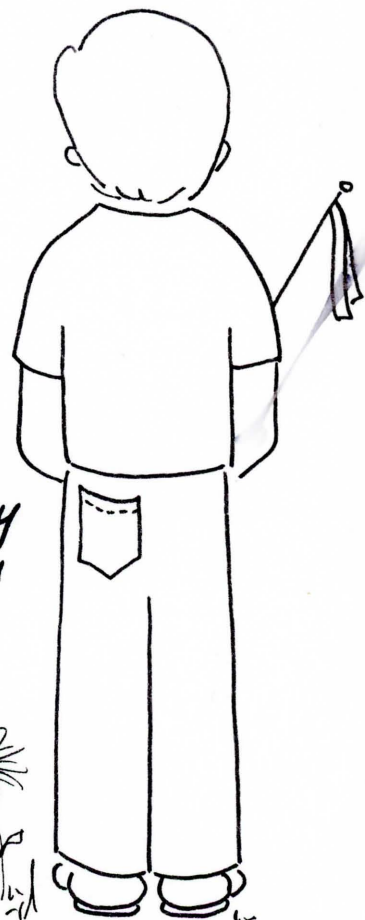
