GOOD NEWS!

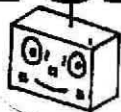
DON BELFORT'S newest attraction is an electric, retract outfitted, simulated machine gun noise making Zero...quite a ship!

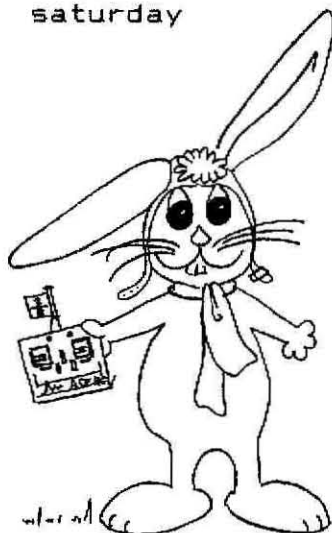
